On Tuesday, the Legislature convened the Second Regular Session of the 34<sup>th</sup> Alaska State Legislature. The Senate intends to continue to build upon the priorities set out last session. I continue as one of the tri-chairs of the Senate Finance Committee and I am responsible for the State Operating budget. Alongside tri-chairs Senator Stedman, who is in charge of the Capital budget and Senator Olson, who is responsible for bills/legislation.

As many of you are aware, this will be my last Legislative session. This year marks my 40<sup>th</sup> year as a state legislator. At this time, I would like to extend my deepest appreciation to my wife and my family. A person cannot do this job without family support. They have always had my back and stood with me on my decisions.

I am fortunate to have all my staff returning this session.
